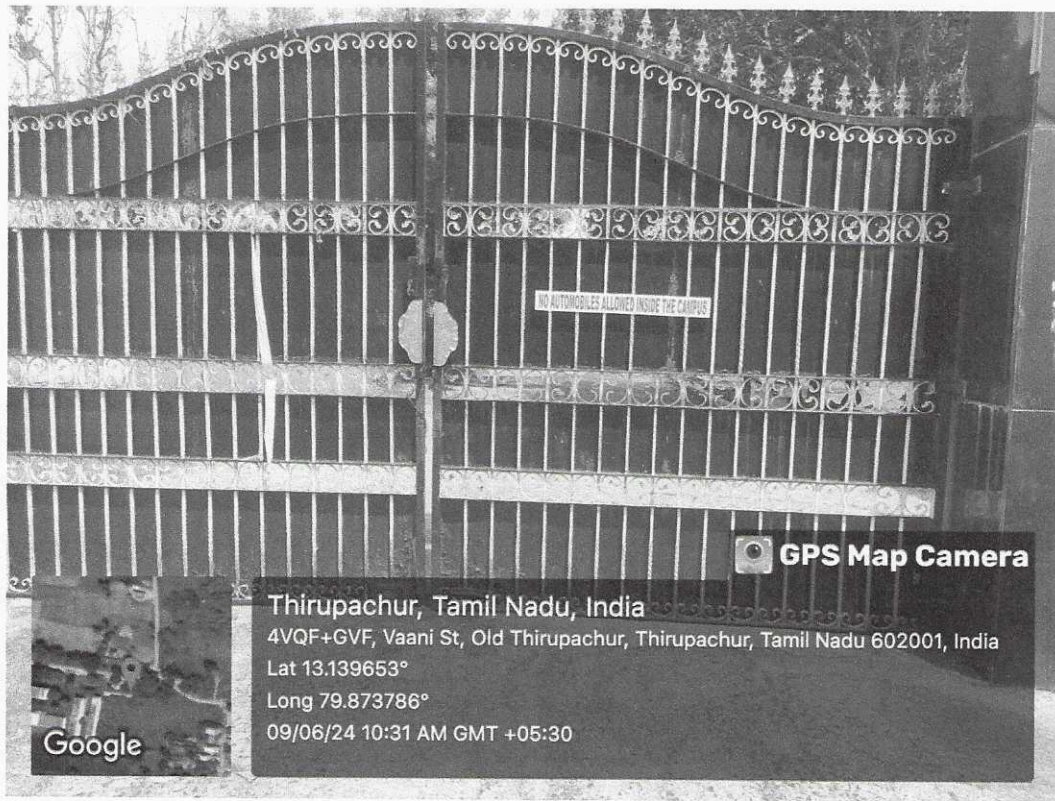

1. Restricted entry of automobiles

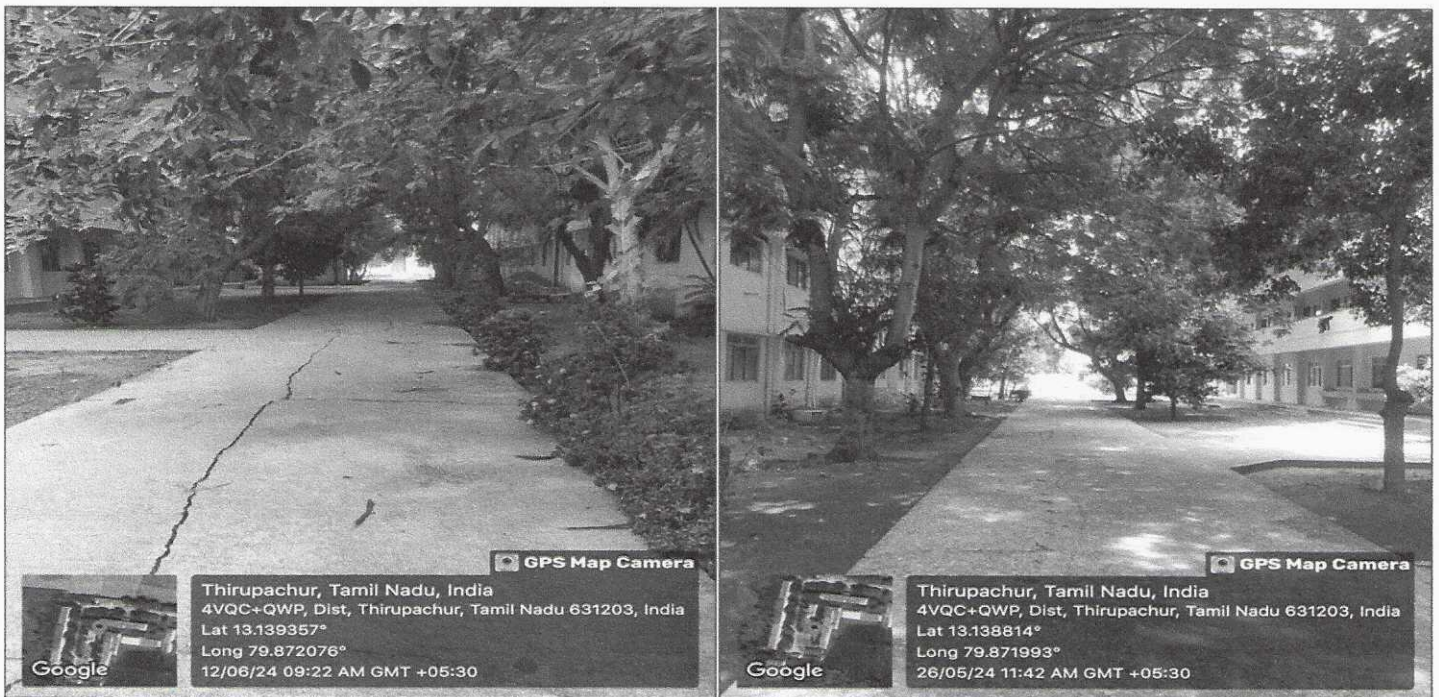
